He provided decision making advice in the early phases of the design on equipment operating principles and helped in the selection of types of equipment to be used. He provided process design flow diagrams and later equipment arrangement designs for the actual plant design. The detailed structural, electrical and mechanical connections between equipment was done by local engineering firms with advice as necessary by Mr. Wilkins. He provided ongoing advice by telephone, letter and individual sketches of components of the detailed design and construction. He provided ongoing advice during startup and operation of the Refinery. Mr. Wilkins has actual hands on operation experience of all types of refinery equipment during his 25 years of supervisory responsibility with the Newark California Solar Plant and Refinery.

Well Brines Chemicals Pvt. Ltd. Refinery was completed as planned and operated satisfactorily until the earthquake in 2001. Mr. Wilkins was asked to provide plans for a replacement of the destroyed Refinery. He provided plans for a lower height structure steel frame building through the use of more elevators to eliminate the high multistory original design and physical equipment layouts in an open three floor arrangement. The washery and dryer were located outside the main refinery building. The finished plant design was done locally. The local company engineers now had over 12 years refinery operating experience.
